### National Referral Mechanism (NRM) process:

The NRM is a NATIONAL framework for identifying victims of human trafficking and ensuring they receive the appropriate support and protection.

First Responders: Police, UK Border Force, Home Office Immigration & Visas, Gangmasters Licensing Authority, Local uthorities, Salvation Army, Poppy Project, Migrant Help, Medaille Trust, Kalayan, Barnardos, Unseen, NSPCC, BAWSO, New Pathways, Refugee Council

UK Human Trafficking Centre at the National Crime Agency (referrals from the police, local authorities and Non-Government Organisations)

Home Office Immigration & Visas (referrals identified as part of the immigration process or asylum claim)
